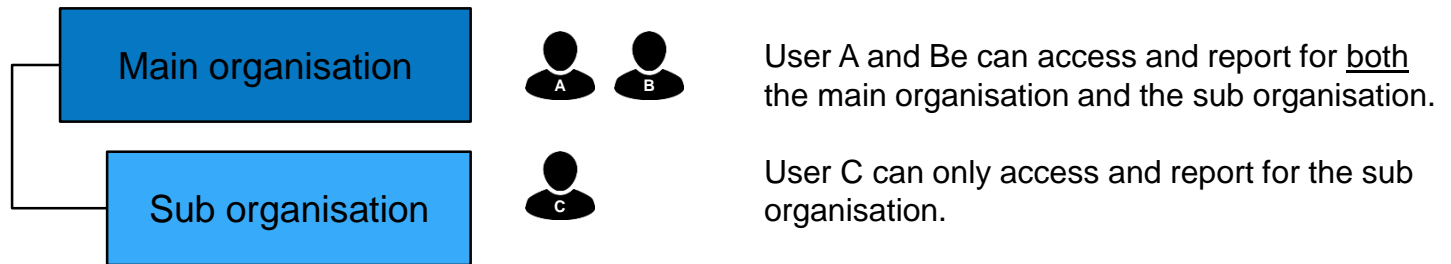
How to register an organisation and a user in goAML

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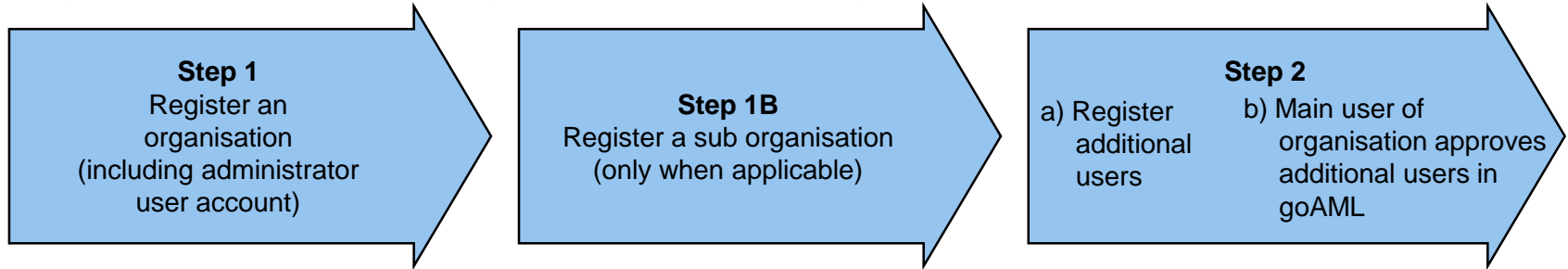
Introduction, how to register in goAML

- goAML is the reporting system to the Swedish Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU Sweden), to be used by the reporting entities. The system replaced the previous system DAR during the spring 2020. During spring 2022, the user interface will be updated, hence this version of the user guide will replace and complement the previous user guide.
- The information in this manual is to be used by reporting entities that report in accordance with the Anti-Money Laundering Act.
- If an organisation is obligated to report within several branches then the reporting entity needs to register each branch separately. The first step is to create a main organisation and then register the other branches as sub organisations. Please contact FIU Sweden before registering a sub organisation.
- Please note that if an organisation consists of several branches, and has both a main and one or more sub organisations, this will effect the access of the users. A user connected to the main organisation can access the account and report for both the main organisation and the sub organisation. A user connected to the sub organisation can only report for the sub organisation.



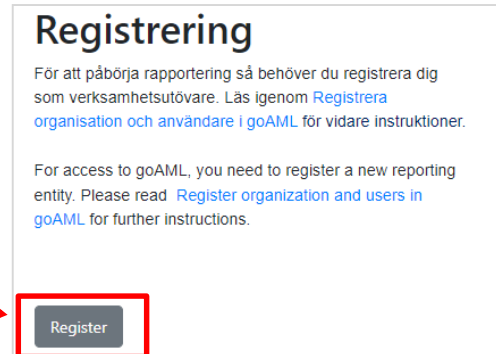
Step by step for how to register in goAML

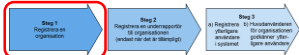

The administrator user is registered at the same time as the organisation

- Enter the details related to the first user of the organisation (more users can be added later). The first user will automatically be the administrator of the organisation.
- The user name must be unique, make sure to remember what you choose (it is possible to use an email address as user name).
- The email connected to the user can only be used once, i.e. unique email addresses must be used if adding more users
- The password must have minimum 12 and maximum 25 characters and must contain:
 - At least one lowercase
 - At least one uppercase
 - At least one number (0-9)
 - At least one special character: `-+!#%?*.,@?${}=_?~^&"'<>`

Step 1B: How to register a sub organisation (when applicable)

This information concerns organisations that have several branches, i.e. an obliged entity that is a bank but also has a branch that involves mortgages. **Please contact FIU Sweden for advice before registering a sub organisation.**

Example

“Bank of Sweden” has a permit as a “bank- och finansieringsrörelse” , in accordance to 1. as well as “bostadskredit” (Mortgage of Sweden”) in accordance to 12. in 1 kap. 2 § i Lag (2017:630) om åtgärder mot penningtvätt och finansiering. “Bank of Sweden” needs to be registered first, see step 1 in this manual. When approved by FIU Sweden, the administrator for “Bank of Sweden” may register “Mortgage of Sweden” as a sub organisation to “Bank of Sweden”. Follow the instructions in step 1B in this manual.





Step 1B: Register a sub organisation

1. Log in to goAML as the administrator for the main organisation.
2. Choose the menu "Admin" >> "Active Organizations" where you find a list of organisations and its organisation ID. Hence only one organisation exist so far, only one is shown at this stage.
3. To create a sub organisation, click on the button "Create New Delegating Organization".
4. Add the necessary information as described in step 1 and then click "Submit Request"

Step 1C: Register a user/person to the sub organisation

- When FIU Sweden has approved the sub organisation you need to register at least one user for the sub organisation. This is done in the same way as in step 2.
- Remember to state the organisation ID of the sub organisation.
- In the example below “Sverigelån” and “Sverigekredit” are sub organisations to “Sverigebanken”. If you wish to register a user to the sub organisation “Sverigekredit” then the organisation ID “5” is to be stated.
- The first registered user to the sub organisation will be its administrator.

Step 2A: Register a user


- Every person in the organisation that is supposed to submit reports need to register a user in goAML.
- To register a user the organisation ID for the organisation in goAML is needed. The organisation ID is provided by the administrator (see next page).
- The administrator is responsible for approving new users and changes for existing users.
- Click on “REGISTER” and then “Register a User”.

1. "Organisation ID" is the unique ID number in goAML for the organisation to which the user is to be linked. The administrator may find this number in the e-mail that was received when the registration of the organisation was approved. The organisation ID can also be found by the administrator by logging in to goAML and choosing the menu "ADMIN" >> "Active organizations".
2. The user name must be unique. Please make sure to note which user name you have chosen, you will need it for logging in. (An e-mail address may be used as a user name.)
- The password must have minimum 12 and maximum 25 characters and must contain:
 - At least one lowercase
 - At least one uppercase
 - At least one number (0-9)
 - At least one special character: -+!#%?*.,@?\${}=_?~^&'<>

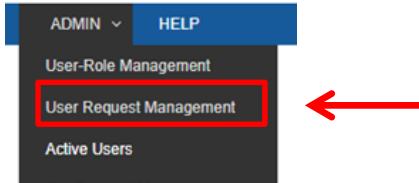

Step 2B: Approving or rejecting new users

The administrator is the one that can make changes for the organisation. The administrator should check the menu *ADMIN >> User Request Management* for new users waiting to be approved.

2. Click on [Waiting for approval-1](#) and review the information. If the information is correct click on “Approve”. If something isn’t correct or it is a new user that shouldn’t report for the organisation, click on “Reject”.

3. The approved user may now log in to the portal.

Roles in goAML

- There are two different roles in goAML:
 - Administrator (RE admin)
 - User (RE user)
- As the administrator you have full access for your organisation. You are also the one who approves new users.
- The user registered with the organisation will automatically be the administrator.
- An organisation may have more than one administrator.
- As a user you may submit reports and handle the message board.
- If an organisation only has one administrator, another user must be assigned the administrator role if the original administrator no longer is to report for the organisation and needs to be inactivated in goAML.
- Check the FAQ for instructions on how to change roles.
